DO



Get medical attention, even if you don't think you're hurt



Gather as much information as you can about the other car



Speak to any witnesses who may have seen the wreck



Call your insurance company to report the incident

DON'T



Chase after the other car; doing so can put you in more danger



Leave the scene before the police say you're allowed to do so



Admit guilt in any way, as you could still be found at fault



Forget about or forego speaking to an attorney about your case
